

THE PARTICULARS: Candidates must be at least 18 years old and committed to pursuing a career in theatre. The program runs June 3 through August 18, 2018, costs \$4,950, and includes furnished off-campus housing. All participants will have at least one roommate. Complete the application and send with the following (check each box):

Resume

One-page essay stating why you want to participate in the program, where you are in your professional development as an actor and where you believe you need to focus your training in the future.

Three letters of recommendation, at least two of which are focused on your theatrical and/or academic work.

Auditions are required and should include a contemporary monologue and 16 bars of a musical theatre piece that showcases your range. Representatives will be available at the 2018 spring NETC conference. Upon receipt of all application materials, BTG will contact you to set up an interview.
