The Summer Acting Internship Program is a 11-week intensive with classroom and stage experience led by Artistic Associate David Adkins. Our highly acclaimed productions are directed, designed and performed by theatre professionals working at the highest levels from the American theatre, film and world of television. Acting Interns not only learn in class and tutorial settings, but through performance in two BTG summer productions.

Acting Interns have worked and attended master classes in the past with BTG Company Members Travis Daly, Tara Franklin, Keira Naughton, Eric Hill, Alan Filderman, Gerry McIntryre, Gregg Edelman, Tom Story, Isadora Wolfe, Jeremy Davidson, Jane Atkinson, Michel Gill, Harriet Harris, Matt Sullivan and Kate Maguire. The program is intense in actor training, as well as vigorous in its immersion into all areas of the theatre. Participants will have rare and unique opportunities to gain insight into the experience of working at a professional theatre.

**DATES:**

May 17, 2020 through August 1, 2020

**COST:**

The total cost of the Acting Intern Program is \$4950. This includes housing as well as all training programs. A weekly meal plan is available for an additional fee.

**AGE REQUIREMENT:**

Applicants must be 18 years of age. Typically students are college age, as the program provides a bridge from educational life to a life in the professional world.

**EMC POINTS AND COLLEGE CREDITS:**

Acting interns are able to obtain EMC points through understudy opportunities for BTG productions. College credit may be available through some academic institutions, applicants should contact their college department heads for information.

Application, audition, headshot, resume and interview is required for admittance.
